Submit work samples that were **completed no longer than two (2) years ago**. Submit no more than five (5) pages of your writing.

Visual Artists

Submit 6-8 jpeg images of work **completed no longer than two (2) years ago**, on a Windows compatible CD, no larger than 2MB file size per photo. Performance artists & sculptors may provide a video. Include an inventory sheet with corresponding numbers, title, date, medium and dimensions of each submission.

Musicians/Composers + Videographers

Submit samples of compositions **completed no longer than two (2) years ago**. Please provide a link to an online video(s) that can be viewed. Include an inventory sheet with titles and dates.
