Skill level: beginner–intermediate

Supply list:

Portable easel

palette

palette knife

brushes—a range of sizes, prefer bristle brushes

paints (oil or acrylic)

Some suggested colors:

Titanium white

Cadmium yellow (light or medium)

Yellow ochre

Cadmium red (light or medium)

Alizarin Crimson

Ultramarine blue

Phthalo blue

Sap green

Any others you like, just be sure to have white, yellow, red, and blue.

Mineral spirits/brush washer container (water for acrylics)

Paper towels

Painting surfaces:

Stretched canvas, canvas panels, gessoed wood panels

suggested sizes 11” x 14” or smaller
